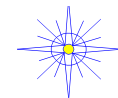
If I am in a proper frame of mind and spirit, my inner being will crave the presence of God as much as the animals of the forest crave water to quench their thirst.

When I think God has forgotten me, I should just remember that I am the one who has forgotten, not Him! Praise Him, Praise Him, Jesus, my blessed redeemer.



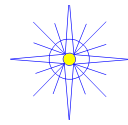

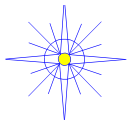


Philippians 2:1-11

Because of Christ's absolute and utter humility, God has raised Him up to be worshiped and adored by all of creation. God has made Jesus name the most spoken name for all time. God will also insure that every person from every era will bow at the name of Jesus. Many may think that they can use His name in vain without any consequences. But, "be not deceived, God is not mocked." Jesus willfully submitted Himself to the most humiliating death (naked, suffocating, raised up for all to see.) God's Son should not have been thusly treated! God will have the last say. The only appropriate response is to worship Jesus!

Eventually, every tongue of every person alive or deceased will confess that Jesus Christ is Lord. God's glory demands it!

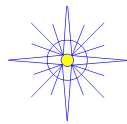
Christ did not die on the cross just to become an object of worship or conversation. Jesus died on the cross for me. Jesus died so that I might live. My sins required the appropriate wages (separation from a Holy God). Jesus took my place and paid my penalty. Jesus then offered me complete and total forgiveness and restoration to holiness in the eyes of God. All I need to do is "accept that I deserved to die, that He died in my place, and that Jesus rose from the grave victorious over death which separated us from God! Hallelujah!



1 If you have any encouragement from being united with Christ, if any comfort from his love, if any fellowship with the Spirit, if any tenderness and compassion, 2 then make my joy complete by being like-minded, having the same love, being one in spirit and purpose.

3 Do nothing out of selfish ambition or vain conceit, but in humility consider others better than yourselves. 4 Each of you should look not only to your own interests, but also to the interests of others. 5 Your attitude should be the same as that of Christ Jesus: 6 Who, being in very nature God, did not consider equality with God something to be grasped, 7 but made himself nothing, taking the very nature of a servant, being made in human likeness. 8 And being found in appearance as a man, he humbled himself and became obedient to death-- even death on a cross!

9 Therefore God exalted him to the highest place and gave him the name that is above every name, 10 that at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, in heaven and on earth and under the earth, 11 and every tongue confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father.

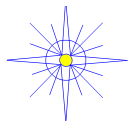

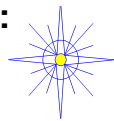


1 Whoever loves discipline loves knowledge, But he who

of the wise brings healing. 19 Truthful lips will be established forever, But
a lying tongue is only for a moment. 20 Deceit is in the heart of those
who devise evil, But counselors of peace have joy.
21 No harm befalls the righteous, But the wicked are filled with trouble.
22 Lying lips are an abomination to the LORD, But those who deal
faithfully are His delight. 23 A prudent man conceals knowledge, But the
heart of fools proclaims folly. 24 The hand of the diligent will rule, But the
