### Thoughts from the Psalms



Psalm 34

### Psalm 34



- 1 I will praise the LORD at all times; his praise is always on my lips. 2 My whole being praises the LORD. The poor will hear and be glad. 3 Glorify the LORD with me, and let us praise his name together.
- 4 I asked the LORD for help, and he answered me. He saved me from all that I feared. 5 Those who go to him for help are happy, and they are never disgraced. 6 This poor man called, and the LORD heard him and saved him from all his troubles.
- 7 The angel of the LORD camps around those who fear God, and he saves them. 8 Examine and see how good the LORD is. Happy is the person who trusts him. 9 You who belong to the LORD, fear him! Those who fear him will have everything they need. 10 Even lions may get weak and hungry, but those who look to the LORD will have every good thing.
- 11 Children, come and listen to me. I will teach you to worship the LORD. 12 You must do these things to enjoy life and have many happy days. 13 You must not say evil things, and you must not tell lies. 14 Stop doing evil and do good. Look for peace and work for it. 15 The LORD sees the good people and listens to their prayers.
- 16 But the LORD is against those who do evil; he makes the world forget them. 17 The LORD hears good people when they cry out to him, and he saves them from all their troubles. 18 The LORD is close to the brokenhearted, and he saves those whose spirits have been crushed. 19 People who do what is right may have many problems, but the LORD will solve them all.
- 20 He will protect their very bones; not one of them will be broken. 21 Evil will kill the wicked; those who hate good people will be judged guilty. 22 But the LORD saves his servants' lives; no one who trusts him will be judged guilty.

## Bible Study Interaction Notes

### **PHILIPPIANS**

Philippians 1:12-20
Regardless of my circumstances and wherever they
place me, I can and should promote the Gospel.
God usually orchestrates circumstances to move
me where He wants me to share His gospel.
Even if I am in the humblest of places (as Paul
in prison), my faith and what I believe about Jesus
should be known by all who have significant
contact with me. It would be a tremendous thing
if virtually everyone I have ever met knew of
my faith in Jesus!
My courage with respect to sharing the gospel
will be contagious. It will produce courage in
others to boldly share their faith as well.
I believe that we Christians are most ineffective
because no one will be a bold example for
others to follow!

Phil 1:12 Now I want you to know, brethren, that my circumstances have turned out for the greater progress of the gospel, <sup>13</sup>so that my imprisonment in the cause of Christ has become well known throughout the whole praetorian guard and to everyone else, 14 and that most of the brethren, trusting in the Lord because of my imprisonment, have far more courage to speak the word of God without fear. <sup>15</sup>Some, to be sure, are preaching Christ even from envy and strife, but some also from good will; <sup>16</sup>the latter do it out of love, knowing that I am appointed for the defense of the gospel; <sup>17</sup>the former proclaim Christ out of selfish ambition rather than from pure motives, thinking to cause me distress in my imprisonment. 18What then? Only that in every way, whether in pretense or in truth, Christ is proclaimed; and in this I rejoice, yes, and I will rejoice. <sup>19</sup>For I know that this will turn out for my deliverance through your prayers and the provision of the Spirit of Jesus Christ, <sup>20</sup>according to my earnest expectation and hope, that I will not be put to shame in anything, but that with all boldness, Christ will even now, as always, be exalted in my body, whether by life or by death.

### Proverbs 4:4

- 4 Then he taught me and said to me, "Let your heart hold fast my words; Keep my commandments and live; (NNAS)
- 4 my father taught me and said, "Hold on to my words with all your heart. Keep my commands and you will live. (NCV)
- 4 he taught me and said, "Lay hold of my words with all your heart; keep my commands and you will live. (NIV)
- 4 He taught me also, and said unto me, Let thine heart retain my words: keep my commandments, and live. (KJV)
- 4 He told me never to forget his words. "If you follow them," he said, "you will have a long and happy life. (TLB)

### Proverb 4

1 Hear, O sons, the instruction of a father, And give attention that you may gain understanding, 2 For I give you sound teaching; Do not abandon my instruction. 3 When I was a son to my father, Tender and the only son in the sight of my mother, 4 Then he taught me and said to me, "Let your heart hold fast my words; Keep my commandments and live; 5 Acquire wisdom! Acquire understanding! Do not forget, nor turn away from the words of my mouth. 6 "Do not forsake her, and she will guard you; Love her, and she will watch over you. 7 "The beginning of wisdom is: Acquire wisdom; And with all your acquiring, get understanding. 8 "Prize her, and she will exalt you; She will honor you if you embrace her. 9 "She will place on your head a garland of grace; She will present you with a crown of beauty." 10 Hear, my son, and accept my sayings, And the years of your life will be many. 11 I have directed you in the way of wisdom; I have led you in upright paths. 12 When you walk, your steps will not be impeded; And if you run, you will not stumble. 13 Take hold of instruction; do not let go. Guard her, for she is your life. 14 Do not enter the path of the wicked, And do not proceed in the way of evil men. 15 Avoid it, do not pass by it; Turn away from it and pass on. 16 For they cannot sleep unless they do evil; And they are robbed of sleep unless they make someone stumble. 17 For they eat the bread of wickedness, And drink the wine of violence. 18 But the path of the righteous is like the light of dawn, That shines brighter and brighter until the full day.

19 The way of the wicked is like darkness; They do not know over what they stumble. 20 My son, give attention to my words; Incline your ear to my sayings. 21 Do not let them depart from your sight; Keep them in the midst of your heart. 22 For they are life to those who find them, And health to all their whole body. 23 Watch over your heart with all diligence, For from it flow the springs of life. 24 Put away from you a deceitful mouth, And put devious lips far from you. 25 Let your eyes look directly ahead, And let your gaze be fixed straight in front of you. 26 Watch the path of your feet, And all your ways will be established. 27 Do not turn to the right nor to the left; Turn your foot from evil.
